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Dear patients and referring physicians,

Neurology Associates is going through some big changes in 2025. We are relocating our main office from 389 Mulberry St to 673 Pine St. Two of our five doctors are retiring, and we've recently inherited patients from three other local neurologists who left practice in 2023-2024. Nationwide with the aging of the population, the demand for neurologists outstrips supply, and wait times for neurologists continue to grow throughout the US. We appreciate the patience and understanding of new patients being referred to our practice during this process.

We are doing our best to reduce wait times for patients in Middle Georgia. One of the steps we're taking is to bring on a nurse practitioner. We'd like to welcome Larry Montgomery, APRN, AGNP-C, to our team. Larry brings with him many years of experience in a primary care setting, and he's been getting additional training in neurology since he joined our practice in mid-2024. Larry works very closely with each of the MDs; we believe in a collaborative relationship between the NP and MD providers. Most patients will be scheduled first for a consultation with one of our MDs, then subsequent follow-up visits will be divided between the NP and MD. Patients who refuse to see the nurse practitioner would be better served by another practice. We appreciate your understanding.

In many cases, patients who previously saw Dr. Holyoya or Dr. Spiegel will be asked to follow up with their primary care providers if their condition is stable. If a patient of Dr. Holyoya or Dr. Spiegel has an active / unstable neurological disease (for example, ongoing seizures, unstable Myasthenia Gravis, active Multiple Sclerosis, or worsening Parkinson's Disease) we will do our best to schedule these patients with one of our continuing neurologists, on a case-by-case basis.

Again, we appreciate your understanding and patience during this time of transition for our practice. We appreciate the trust that you have placed in us to provide care for Middle Georgians living with neurological diseases.
